# CONCLUSIONS

1. **Central Europe priority:** to enhance innovation on (textile) industry by improving linkages among main actors of innovation
2. **ENTeR project:** to address textile materials and recycling processes in a circular economy framework
3. **M3P platform:** to find matches between waste and needed (second) raw materials (Industrial Symbiosis: multi- or cross-sectoral way)
4. **ENTeR partners:** to solve together problems coming from companies when they look at recycling
5. **Pilot cases:**
  - to allow ENTeR partnership to work together in solving them
  - Using the platform as „material match making system”
