Requirements for test specimens

General:

Individual components (additions) and finished manufactured clothing can be tested.

Quantity of material:

Depending on scope of test, approx. 5 m² or 5 ready-made items

Duration of testing:

Depending on scope of test, as a rule 4 weeks from receipt of test specimens. The testing is in staged modules. First the laboratory tests are conducted, and then where relevant the long-term wash trials.
